

Trade waste services providing cost-effective solutions for local businesses

Sudbury Resource Centre has been based on the Chilton Industrial Estate for more than 30 years, providing training and employment opportunities for adults with multiple disadvantages.

Throughout that time the Centre has received support and help from local businesses. As the Centre moved forward it has looked at ways their skills and experience can be used to offer something back to the local business community, by providing outsourcing services which are efficient and cost-effective.

Under the banner Business 4 Sudbury, the Centre's work projects include: Recycling; Assembly and Packing; Catering and Garden services. The largest of these services is the Recycling and Re-Use project, which has expanded and can now provide a cost-efficient service to meet the needs of business.

The Centre formed the Industrial Waste Focus group, supported by many of our local companies, to review the needs of local business and turn waste into a revenue stream instead of a cost. This is being achieved with the launch of the Business Waste Voucher scheme to help companies control cost and get an on-demand service.

Trade Waste Vouchers

Vouchers, with a face value of 75p, are sold in books of 20. One voucher can be used to arrange the collection of a bundle or bag (maximum weight 15kg) of cardboard or paper. Business 4 Sudbury will collect any number of bags or bundles, with no upper limit on weight collected. Businesses can also deliver to the Recycling and Re-Use Project at the Resource Centre on Chilton Industrial Estate.

During the next few weeks, the scheme will be expanding to cover polythene sheeting, shrink wrap, bubble wrap and other similar packaging materials. A free collection service is also available for Aluminium Cans & Foil, Inkjet & Toner Cartridges.

Due to the success of the Centre's waste cardboard recycling service it is also possible to provide a contract service for larger users. All waste collected is monitored, weighed and waste transfer notes issued if required.
